

What?

Writing skill is almost lost - let that not happen to reading

A revivalism to pre-social media time but striving for the robust co-existence of book reading

How?

A 3-year reading programme

Bilingual reading programme (English and one major language) -reading skills are transferable 3 different levels (age appropriate)

Primary - 3 to 5 standards

High school – 6 to 8 standards

Tertiary - 3 years

A 100-module for each level

A module focuses on a specific theme from fiction, non-fiction, periodicals

A module consists of a video, audio, in-session reading texts, engagements, off-session reading texts

A module is for one hour duration led by a mentor - hands-on

Students expected to read the texts introduced

One-hour per week

Extensive reading - reading for joy - organic absorption of languages rather than the academic itemized, serialized and templatized conscious acquisition


















Report for the Caption Writing Contest - Dewcy Decimal System



Special Address on "Differentiated Instruction for Diverse Learners". Report

The IQAC of the college organized a Special Address on "Differentiated Instruction for Diverse Learners" for the first year B.Ed. students on 11-12-2023. Dr. Zulaiha Shakeel, Principal, Wisdom Public School, Veerapandianpattinam served as the resource person. Dr. Zulaiha Shakeel began with the Nation Curriculum Framework (2005) recommendations for inclusive education. She pointed out the importance of inclusive education. By describing the characteristics of learning disabled children, she emphasized the need to differentiate education to suit the needs of the diverse population in the classrooms.

Dr. Zulaiha cited examples of the different categories of learners encountered in the classrooms and the ways in which instruction could be varied to suit their differential needs. By defining the term "Individualized Educational Plan", she made clear the partnership between parents and teachers in developing individualized educational plans. She gave a detailed account of the experience of the school in developing individualized educational plan models. She concluded by reiterating the crucial role of teachers in catering to the diverse needs of learners. 


