Technology played a pivotal role, with students producing and telecasting a short film on International Youth Day that highlighted digital sustainability. The Anti-Drug Day and Anti-Ragging Week events were creatively presented through e-pledges and online quizzes, fostering digital awareness. Field visits to industries like AVM Maris Associates and Venus Home Appliances, as well as inclusive school visits to Good Shepherd School of Deaf and Dumb and Wisdom Public School, provided students with real-world learning experiences. A key innovation was the State-Level Seminar on "Unlocking Women's Wellness", which focused on crucial health issues like PCOS and breast cancer. Socially responsible initiatives such as the Alumni Association's food sponsorship for Blessings Old Age Home and activities during Martyr's Day and Republic Day nurtured empathy and societal awareness. Faculty development programs on Bloom's Taxonomy and Academic Publishing equipped educators with modern teaching methodologies.

The ELTAI Thoothukudi Chapter contributed significantly to this innovative atmosphere with online literary quiz competitions and seminars aimed at improving teaching skills. The Women Development Cell actively promoted gender equality and empowerment through workshops and awareness programs.

The Research Club initiated various research projects, encouraging students to engage in innovative academic inquiry and research, further enhancing the research culture within the institution. Additionally, student-centered creativity was fostered through Talent Shows, Motivational Speeches, and Slogan Contests, all designed to inspire innovation and collaborative learning in a dynamic academic environment. The year's theme highlighted the college's commitment to holistic development, preparing students to be innovative, socially responsible, and capable of thriving in the ever-evolving educational landscape. For the next academic year 2025-2026, the college will strive to build its activities around the theme 'Year of Environmental Consciousness'.
